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RCC 2020 MEET LOCATION The HOOP YMCA

(I-5 South to HWY. 217 North)

- From the Portland Int'l Airport follow AIRPORT WAY 1.6 miles to I-205 (Southbound).
- Follow I-205 for 3 miles then take the EXIT 21B for I-84/CITY CENTER (Westbound) (I-84 is also known as the Banfield Freeway)
- Once on I-84, get into the LEFT LANE.
- Follow I-84 approx. 5.5 miles until it splits—being in the left lane, you'll follow the LEFT FORK of the split.
- As you follow the curve, (still in the left lane), you'll see Downtown Portland across the river on your right.
- This curve plops you instantly onto I-5 (Southbound)
- As you merge onto I-5 — stay in the RIGHT LANE. (For now, follow signs that say SALEM)
- Stay in the RIGHT LANE as you cross over the river on the lower deck of the Marquam Bridge. (follow those Salem signs)
- Once off the bridge either lane puts you on to I-5 (Southbound); (DO NOT accidentally take the Lake Oswego exit)
- Follow I-5 South for approx. 9.5 miles and you'll come to EXIT 292 (HWY. 217/Lake Oswego). Turn Right at the top of the exit, this puts you onto HWY. 217.***
- Follow HWY. 217 for about 4 miles to EXIT 2B/ALLEN BLVD.
- At the top of the exit turn RIGHT onto ALLEN BLVD.
- Follow ALLEN for about .5 mile, (go through the signal at ALLEN & WESTERN)
- About a block past the signal, turn LEFT onto ARCTIC DRIVE.
- Follow ARCTIC DRIVE for about .04 of a mile then turn RIGHT onto SW HARVEST COURT.
- **WELCOME to the Beaverton YMCA — Venue for the 2020 RCC!**

RCC 2020 MEET LOCATION The HOOP YMCA

[HWY 26 West (aka, Sunset Hwy.) to HWY. 217 South]

- From the Portland Int'l Airport follow AIRPORT WAY 1.6 miles to I-205 (Southbound).
- Follow I-205 for 2.5 miles then take the EXIT 21B for I-84 WEST/US-30/CITY CENTER (Westbound) (I-84 is also known as the Banfield Freeway)
- Once on I-84, get into the far LEFT LANE.
- Follow I-84 approx. 5.5 miles until it splits—being in the LEFT LANE, you'll follow the LEFT FORK of the split.
- As you follow the curve, (still in the left lane), you'll see Downtown Portland across the river on your right.
- This curve plops you instantly onto I-5 (Southbound)
- As you merge onto I-5 — get into and stay in the far LEFT LANE.
- Stay in the LEFT LANE as you cross over the river on the lower deck of the Marquam Bridge. (Follow Signs for: BEAVERTON/US 26/CITY CENTER)
- Once off the bridge get into the lane 2nd from the right and go about .8 mile to the EXIT 1D (BEAVERTON/HWY 26 West)
- Follow HWY 26 West for approx. 4.9 miles and you'll come to EXIT 69A (HWY. 217 South/BEAVERTON/TIGARD).
- Follow 217 South for 2.75 miles to EXIT 2B/ALLEN BLVD.
- At the top of the exit turn LEFT onto ALLEN BLVD.
- Follow ALLEN for about .5 miles, (go through the signal at ALLEN & WESTERN)
- About a block past the signal, turn LEFT onto ARCTIC DRIVE.
- Follow ARCTIC DRIVE for about .04 of a mile then turn RIGHT onto SW HARVEST COURT.
